The journey of the students from hesitant beginners to confident learners is a sight to behold. I am proud of the commitment and teamwork shown by both the teachers and students .


This edition of newsletter shows the creativity, hardwork and talent of the students.




# HEALING MIND AND HEALING LIFE




# FOOD HABITS AND NUTRITION



## SESSION ON ELECTROCHEMICAL BIOSENSORS FOR BIOACTIVE MOLECULES





## PARENT- TEACHERS MEETING





## Yoga for Good Health: Meditation and Mindfulness Techniques






## Igguthappa Temple: A Journey into Tradition and Tranquillity





## Session on Wild Orchids and Sacred Groves




## Empowering the Mind and Growing Through Adversity

## Parent Teachers Meeting- A Collaborative Approach




